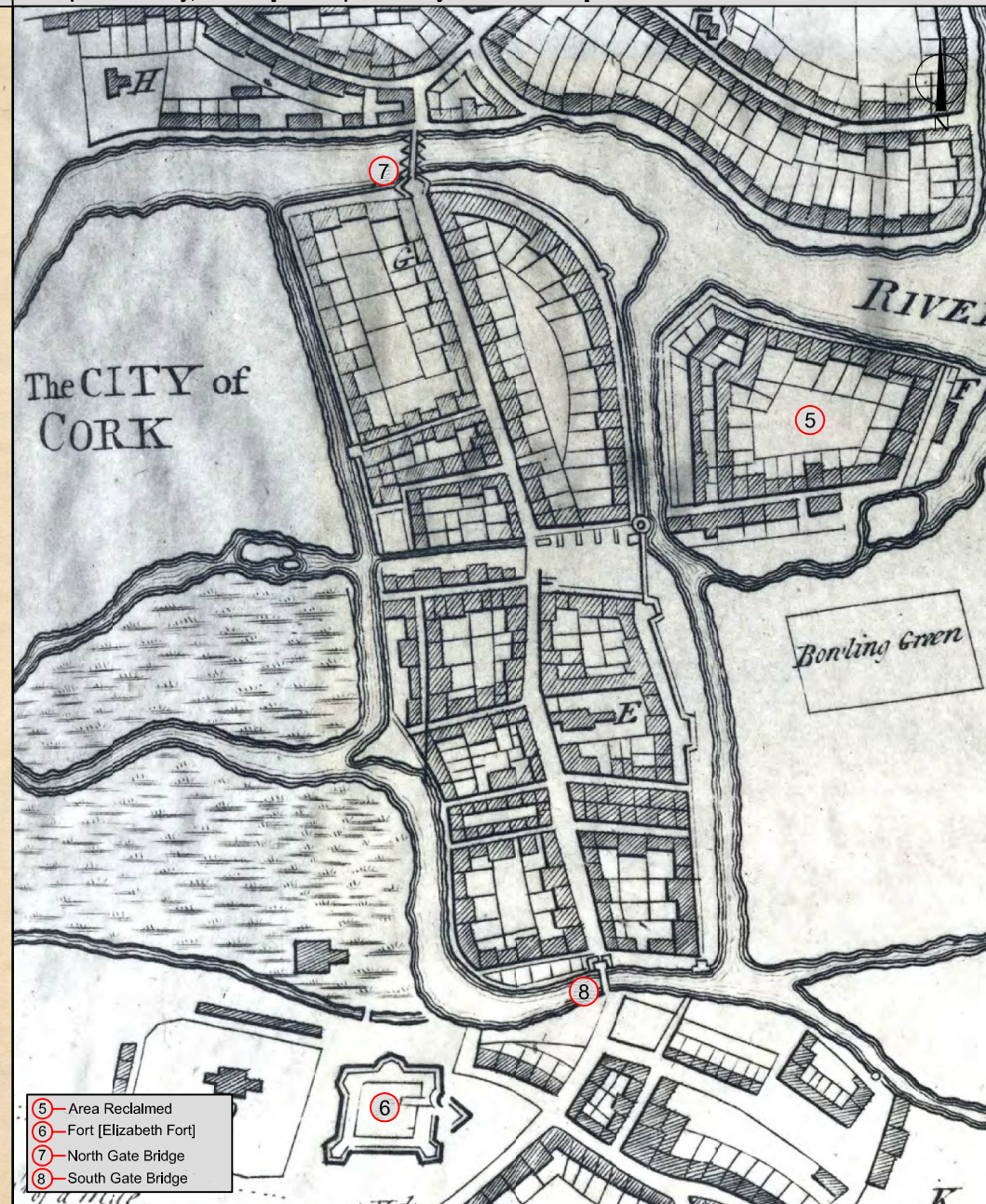


A- Map extracted from the *Pacata Hibernia* 1585-1600 [map thought to date from 1600].
