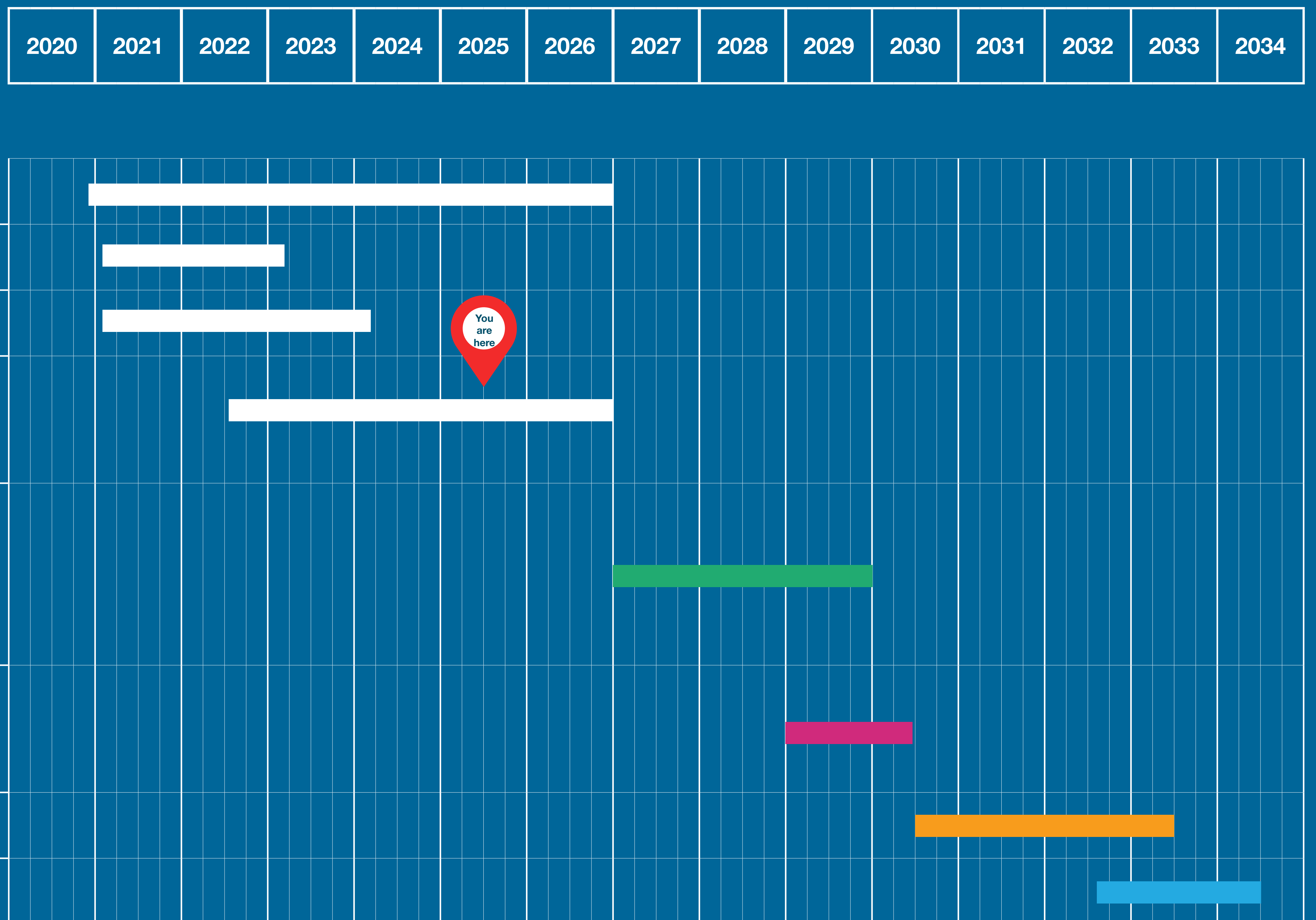
Next Steps

All feedback received in response to the Public Engagement Day will be examined by GCC, OPW and Arup and will be considered when developing the emerging Preferred Option.

Flood relief options for the scheme will be assessed based on feedback received, and environmental, technical and economic viability. When this process is complete an emerging Preferred Option will be identified.

The emerging Preferred Option will be presented to the public at a third Public Engagement Day. Public feedback will be incorporated into the final design of the Preferred Option. The Preferred Option will be progressed through to Stage 2 of the Scheme – the planning consent process. In Stage 2 the Environmental Impact Assessment report will be prepared for the Scheme.
