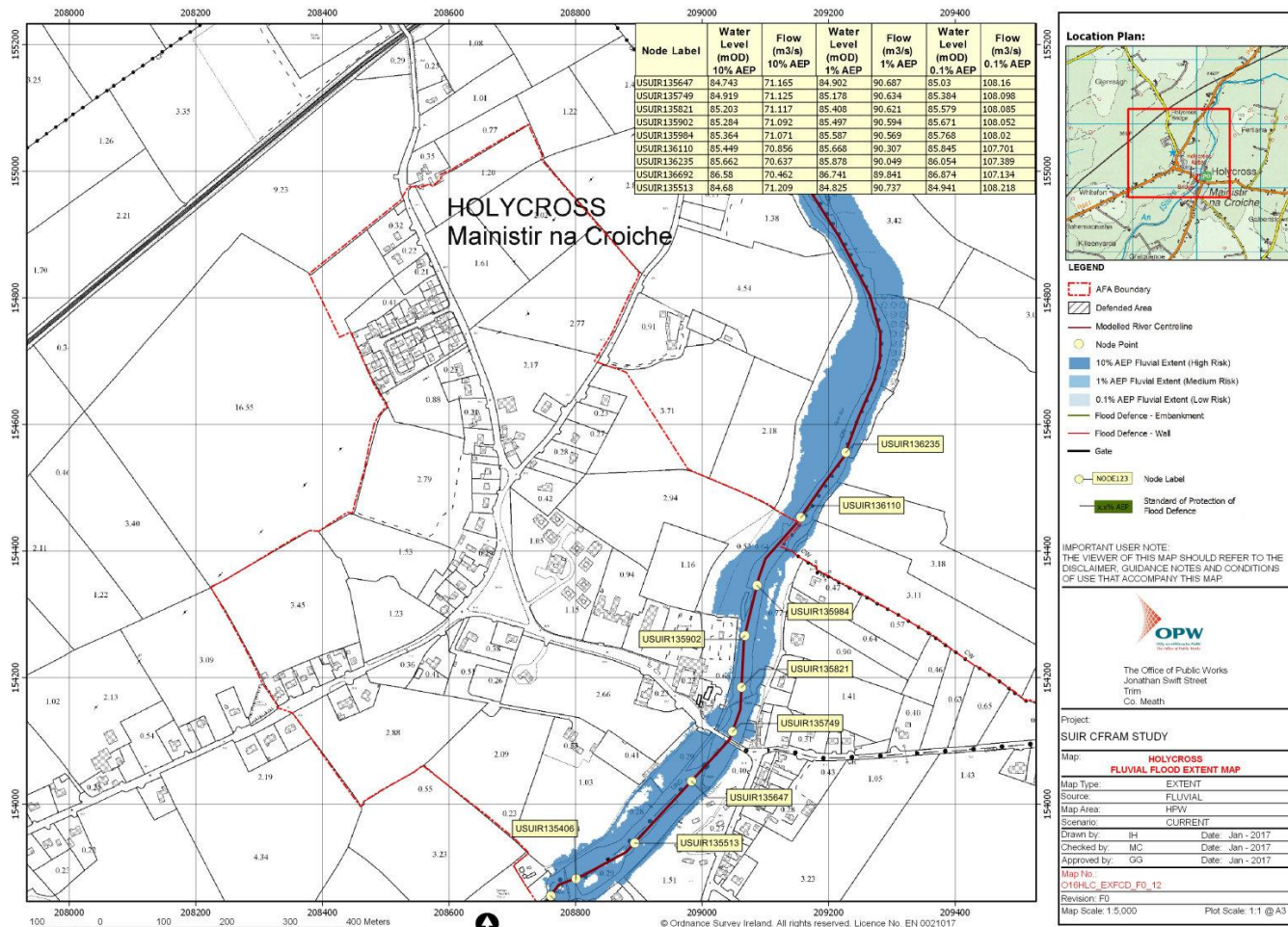
Project Purpose

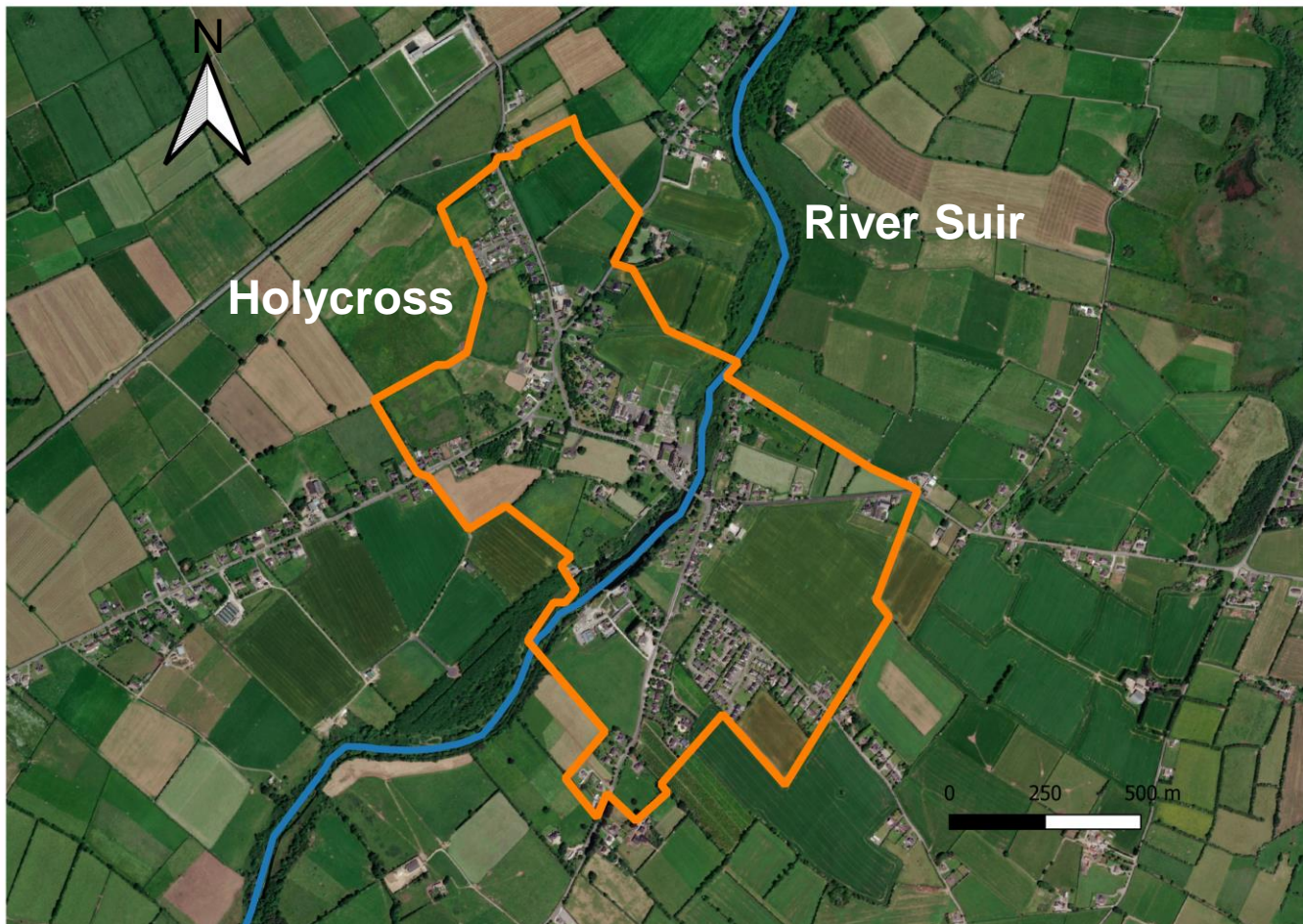

Flood Relief Scheme Stages

Stage I: Scheme Development and Design



Stage 1

- Data collection
- Surveys
- **Public consultation meetings**
- Hydrology and Hydraulic Reports
- Interim Works Report
- Cost Benefit Assessment
- Site investigation
- Scheme Report

Stage II: Planning/ Development Consent



Stage 2

- Part 8 or Part 10 Documentation
- Environmental Impact Assessment Report (if required) and Natura Impact Statement Report
- **Public Consultation meeting**
- Planning consent

Stage III: Detailed Construction Design and Tender



Stage 3

- Complete detail design final preferred scheme
- Contract documentation, Tender Assessment and Procurement of works contractor

Stage IV: Construction



Stage 4

- Supervise construction of work
- Supervise the contract

Stage V: Handover of Works



Stage 5

- Commissioning of works
- Safety File Submission
