Re: River Dodder Flood Alleviation Scheme Phase 3 – Public Consultation Day

Dear Sir/ Madam

Dublin City Council in partnership with Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council and the Office of Public Works are progressing with the River Dodder Flood Alleviation Scheme Phase 3. Engineering and Environmental consultants Ayesa have been appointed to design a flood alleviation scheme that is technically, socially, environmentally and economically acceptable.

The project is currently in Stage 1 – Scheme Analysis and Development. Data collection and surveys (technical and environmental) have been completed along with hydrological and hydraulic modelling and options development. In June 2023, we presented a number of options to the public at a consultation event. Since then we have developed a preferred option to reduce flood risk within the scheme area.

Our aim is to ensure that any designs are based on the most up to date information and analysis, and that stakeholder and public input regarding environmental matters and the nature of the emerging scheme are considered.

We are pleased to advise that we are holding a Public Consultation Day on the **18th June 2025** at the **Dropping Well Pub, Milltown Road, Dublin, D06 YK38** from **2pm till 8pm**. At this event we will present the proposed flood mitigation measures, gather all stakeholder views in relation to the form and type of defence proposed and offer an opportunity to engage directly with the project team.
