## Meeting Minutes:

- 1. Monthly Environmental Audit reports:
  - Monthly reports for May and June were discussed, NOC to revert to ECoW with a number of comments. It noted the updated reports for March and April are still outstanding. NOC to follow up.
- 2. EMG have requested a copy of the electrofishing licence application (for the remainder of the scheme) from Sorensen, but not received it yet. GW to follow up.
- 3. ECoW Memo 17 Proposed gravel removal from Glashaboy at Meadowbrook was discussed and the recommendation of the ECoW was accepted, i.e. that this area of gravel deposit is left undisturbed.
- 4. ECoW Memo 18 Proposed additional tree felling in Meadowbrook was discussed and the recommendation of the ECoW was accepted. i.e. tree felling can proceed once the conditions set out by ECoW are complied with.
