

Scheme Objectives and Overview

Viable, Cost-effective and Sustainable Flood Relief Scheme

The Office of Public Works (OPW), in partnership with Galway County Council (GCC), have appointed Arup in conjunction with Hydro-Environmental Ltd. to assess, develop and design a viable, cost-effective and environmentally sustainable flood relief scheme for Ballinasloe. Ryan Hanley Ltd. has also been appointed to undertake the environmental appraisals for the scheme.

Shown is an indicative flow chart outlining the process from inception through construction for the Flood Relief Scheme.
