Why a flood relief scheme?

The purpose of this **Flood Relief Scheme** is to lessen the effects of flooding and to protect the community of **Graiguenamagh-Tinnahinch** against future flood events. The aim is to provide a scheme that is technically, socially, environmentally, and economically acceptable.

Kilkenny County Council has appointed Engineering and Environmental Consultants ByrneLooby, an Ayesa company to design and implement the proposed **Flood Relief Scheme**.

Kilkenny County Council will be working with the Office of Public Works to deliver the project.

On Tuesday 9th August 2022, at the Hub, Graiguenamagh from 2pm-7pm, we are gathering feedback from the public about your thoughts and preferences on the emerging options for flood relief.

We welcome **your comments** on potential environmental risks, constraints and issues within the Study Area. Your views on the implementation of solutions are appreciated.


