

## Lower Lee (Cork City) Drainage Scheme



UWW_R05	0 to 19	C01_14745	Proposed regrading of the existing road to achieve a crest at flood defence level of 14.85mOD, up to 0.6m above existing ground levels.
UWW_E04	0 to 67	C01_14750 to C01_14775	Proposed flood defence embankment to flood defence level of 15.05mOD, typically 0.8m above existing ground levels. Crest width to be 4m with 1 in 3 side slopes. Proposed flood defence embankment to tie into existing high ground levels at the western end and the proposed road regrading at the eastern end. The embankment will not interfere with the existing flood relief channel.
