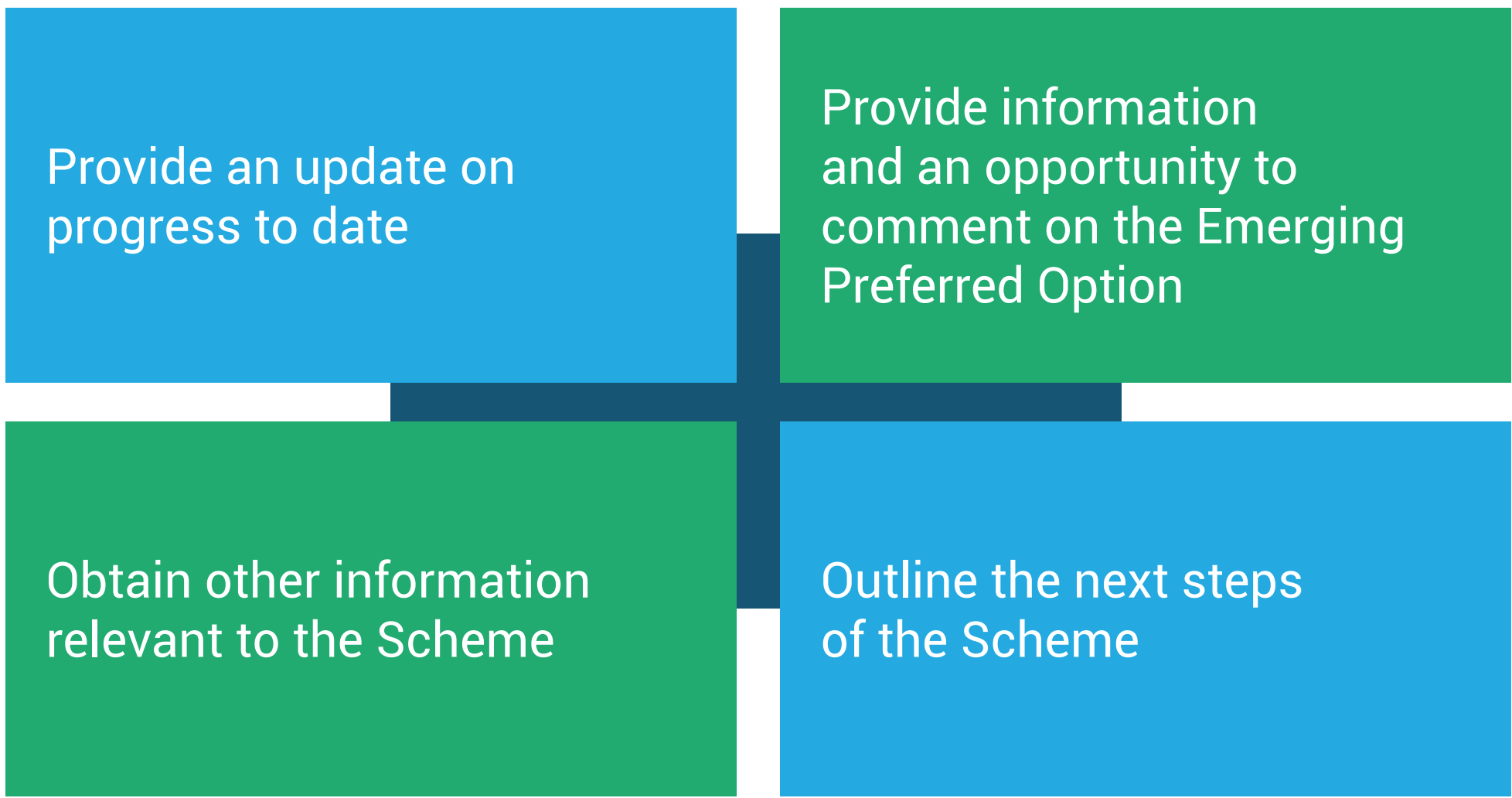

- Environmental surveys.
- Detailed appraisals of every single option considering technical, social, economic & environmental factors prior to selecting the Emerging Preferred Option
- Preparation of draft Options Report

Emerging Preferred Option Consultation Day

- Presentation of the emerging preferred Option.
- A chance to take part and make your views and comments known on the preferred scheme.

What happens next

- Scheme Review, taking into consideration your views.
- Preparation of the final Options Report
- Preparation of the Preferred Scheme documentation.
- Appropriate Assessment- Environmental Impact Assessment.

Statutory Public Exhibition

- Public Exhibition of the scheme in accordance with the requirements of the Arterial Drainage Act, where the public's view of the proposals will be ascertained.
- Refining the scheme in consideration of your views

And then?

- Undertaking the detailed design of the scheme
- Confirmation of the scheme by the Minister for Public Expenditure & Reform.
- Preparation of contract documents and undertaking the procurement of a works contractor to construct the scheme.
