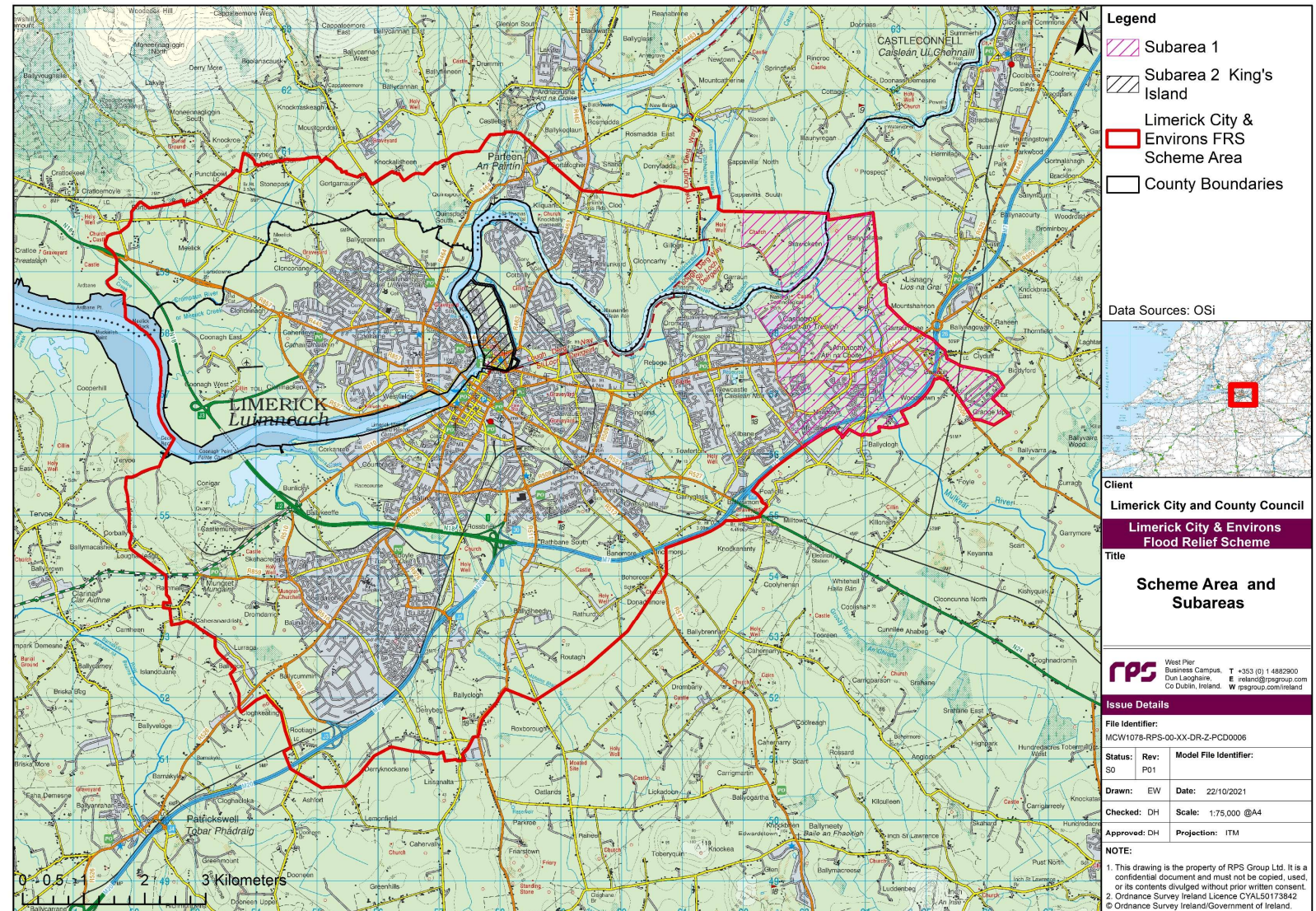


# Scheme Area

The scheme area encompasses the City of Limerick and selected environs situated in both counties Limerick and Clare. The scheme area boundary shown on the adjacent map represents the area within which flood defences are proposed to be constructed, accessed and maintained as part of Limerick City and Environs Flood scheme.

The areas that are intended to benefit from, and be protected by the scheme are broken into three subareas:

- **Subarea 1 – Annacotty**  
Annacotty has been identified as an area where potential “Quick wins” (i.e. early flood risk management / scheme implementation) can be utilised for accelerated works.
- **Subarea 2 – King's Island**  
The King's Island Flood Relief Scheme (KIFRS) is an advanced development that is being progressed by Arup & JBA Consulting Engineers as a separate project to the Limerick City and Environs Flood Relief Scheme.
- **Subarea 3 – City Centre Public Realm**



Limerick City Centre is a potential area of “Quick Win” implementation. The City Centre Riverside Public Realm forms part of the overall scheme area and is broken into 10 zones:

Zone 1: Steamboat Quay  
Zone 2: Shannon Bridge to Sarsfield Bridge  
Zone 3: Honan's Quay  
Zone 4: Arthur's Quay  
Zone 5: Custom House Quay

Zone 6: Kings Island Flood Relief Scheme Advanced Development  
Zone 7: King John's Castle  
Zone 8: Brown's Quay / New Road  
Zone 9: Clancy Strand  
Zone 10: O' Callaghan Strand
